

NAEA Platform and Position Statements

Draft position statements are voted on by the Board of Directors. If approved they become a "position" of the Association. Proposed revisions to adopted position statements under three year review voted on by the Board of Directors.

Early Spring/NAEA Convention

Draft position statements and proposed revisions to adopted position statements are discussed and presented for consensus voting at Delegates Assembly for recommendation to the Board for consideration.

Early Spring

Draft position statements are vetted by multiple groups including members-at-large and posted on the NAEA website for member review.

Winter

NAEA Position Statements

(1st review at 3 years; every 5 years thereafter)

Process is managed by the **Platform Working Group**

4 Vice Presidents and 7 Division Directors

Meets 8-10 times annually beginning in the fall using conference calling and web-based tools.

A position topic is raised by:

Anytime (preference given to summer/fall submissions for spring Delegates Assembly review).

Draft position statements are shaped by expert authors.

Fall/Winter (by Dec. 1)

Adopted position statements are reviewed by the Platform Working Group and proposed revisions are vetted by multiple groups including members-at-large and posted on the NAEA website for member review.
